We don't all grow the same thing or variety.

I also grow purple carrots, red cabbage, beetroot, onions and garlic e.t.c. All super foods and the colours are good as well.

A lot of people have small gardens, but you can grow in pots, up fences, in-between flowers or a windowsill. Even a few herbs is a start, and great in your cooking.
